


Malorie Blackman was born in London in 1962.

Afterwards she worked as a computer programmer.




Malorie's 1st book was published in 1990.

Malorie has never stopped writing since.




In 1992 Malorie married Neil Morrison.

Her hobbies include piano and computer games.




Malorie's Noughts and Crosses novels are famous.

Malorie has received many awards for these novels.




Malorie has written about racism in her books.

Her works have been translated into 15 languages.




