
In January 1660 Pepys began to keep a diary.



He recorded his daily life for almost ten years.




In July 1942 Anne began to keep a diary.

But he  re-wrote it and  bound it into  6  volumes.


At first  Anne  wrote her diary for  herself.

 Later on she  re-wrote it for  other people to  read.




