 WW1 started after an assassination.




In 1918 the war ended.



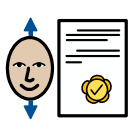
Both sides signed a peace treaty.

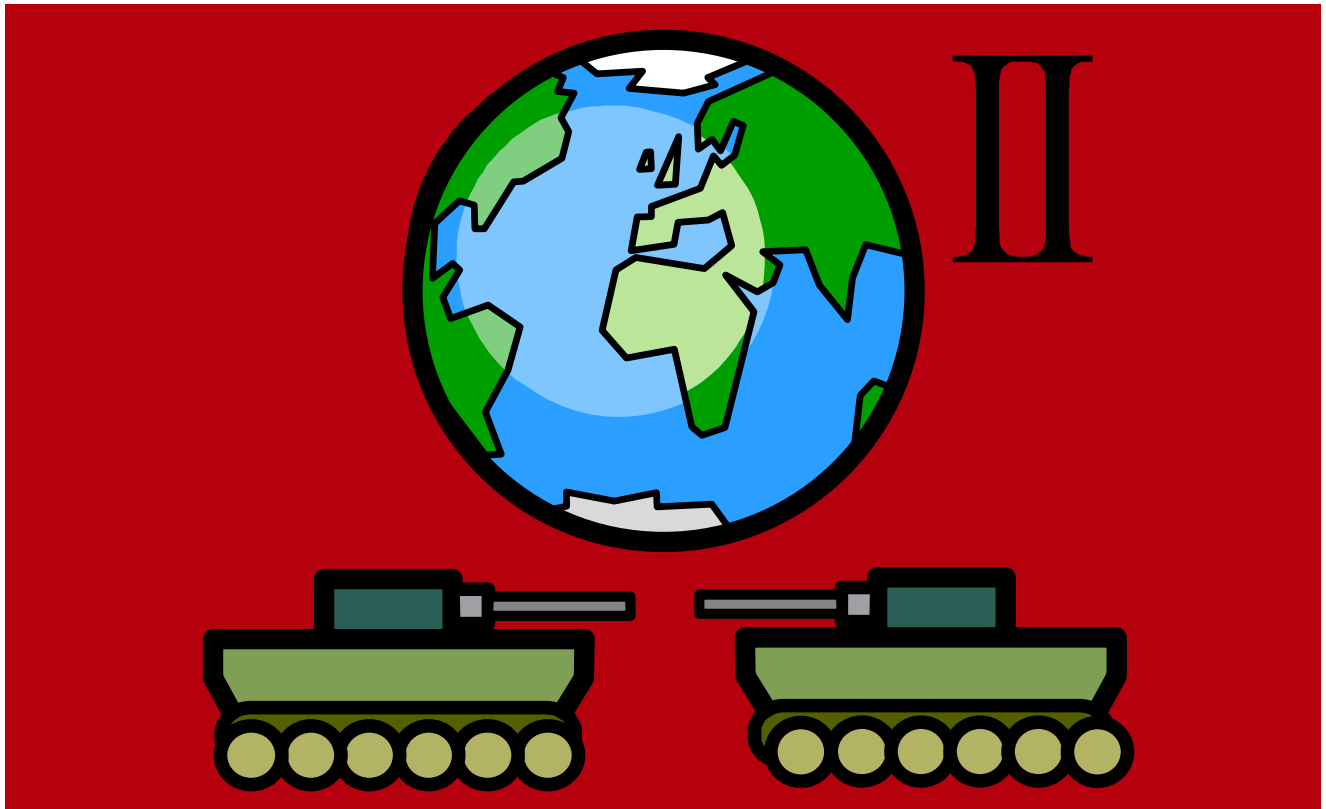
