passage of text.




Abraham lives in the land of Canaan.


He asks his servant to find a wife for his son.

It is evening and the women are coming to the well.




The servant asks God for help.

The right woman will offer water to the servant.

The servant waits by the well.

Rebekah offers water to the servant and camels.

Rebekah comes to the well.

Rebekah is pretty and has never slept with a man.

The servant asks her for a drink.

The servant and camels need a place to sleep.

The servant gives Rebekah a gold ring and some bracelets.

He asks, "Who is your father?"

And is there room in his house for us to sleep?"

Rebekah offers food and a place to sleep.

Rebekah's father is the son of Abraham's brother.

She says, "We have straw for your camels.

We also have a place for you to sleep."




The servant knows Rebekah is the right woman.

The servant bows down and worships God.

He knows God is blessing Abraham.

He knows God has led him to the right woman.



Rebekah talks to her brother.

Rebekah's brother is called Laban.

Rebekah tells Laban about the servant and his camels.

She shows Laban the gold ring and bracelets.



The men talk about Rebekah marrying Isaac.

Laban helps feed the camels.

Laban gives the servant some water to wash his feet.

Laban offers the servant some food to eat and they talk.



Rebekah's father believes God wants the marriage.

Rebekah's father is happy for her to marry Isaac.

He says she can go with the servant to marry Isaac.

Rebekah is happy to go and does not want to wait.




Rebekah goes with the servant and the camels.

He looks up and sees the camels coming.




Rebekah sees Isaac and puts a veil over her face.
