



# Mandalas

A mandala design radiates out symmetrically from the centre.




You can find mandalas everywhere in nature.






- In flowers, tree rings and snowflakes.




- In spider webs, sea shells and crystals.



You can draw on paper or build with stones or sea shells.




Begin in the centre, and work outwards.


