










   
After winter comes the spring,






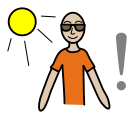
