




Spring is a season of changes.





The weather can be warm, cold, sunny or rainy.





Spring comes after the winter.




The days grow longer and warmer.



The months of spring are March, April and May.




Plants begin to grow again after the winter.





Flowers and blossoms appear.

The  world  comes to  life  again in  spring.


The  first  flowers to appear are  snowdrops and  daffodils.

 Bluebells are  flowers that  grow in  woodlands.


 Tulips can be  white,  red,  yellow or  purple.



The flowers on trees are called blossoms.




Blossoms can be pink, purple or white.




Trees, lawns and hedges grow again in spring.




In the  spring  all  sorts  of insects  appear.




 Ants  live  in  large  colonies  underground.

 Bees  live  in  special  nests  called  beehives.


 Snails  and  slugs  appear  in  gardens  after  the  rain.




In the  spring  some  snakes  shed their skins.


 They  grow  a  new  skin  to  replace  the  old.


 Frogs  lay frog spawn  in the  spring.

 Tadpoles  hatch  from  the  frog spawn.












 Frogs have different stages in their life cycle.









 Tadpoles grow into froglets, before becoming frogs.
