Show the usher your ticket and seat number.

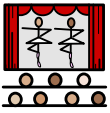


The usher will tell you where to sit.

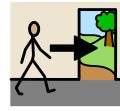
At the end of the performance the audience will clap and cheer.



The dancers, conductor and orchestra will bow in turn.



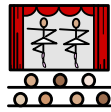
The curtains will close and the lights will come up.



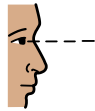
You can leave your seat and go to the exit.
