with one of my trusted adults. I can talk














They will help me do something to feel









Only adults will light the fireworks.












I will stand far back from bonfires and fireworks.













If fireworks are on the ground, I will not touch them.










It is very important to stay safe on Bonfire Night.

I will hold the bottom of the sparkler away from my body and others.










The tip is very hot and is never safe to touch.













Many people come together to celebrate Bonfire Night.










