
Recolouring Images

Sometimes you will want a symbol to display in specific colours. InPrint 4 has a feature that allows you to easily change colours for **Widgit Symbols** and **Media**.

Changing the Colour of Widgit Symbols

When you have placed a symbol in a 1. document select Edit Colours from the Edit tab. Fdit Colours... car The Symbol Palette will open. Click a 2. square to select a colour to change, and then choose the replacement colour in the pop-up. Click **OK** when you are finished. ore Colours. Cancel OK Cancel The symbol will now display as 3. recoloured. car car 4. You will see this new colourway on the right, in the **Symbol Chooser**. **Right-click** to **Set this as the Default** Set this as the Default Symbol Symbol. **Changing the Colour of Widgit Media 1.** When you have placed a **Widgit Media** item in a document, select Edit Colours from the **Edit** tab.

Edit Colours. 2. The Symbol Palette will open. Click a square to select a colour to change, and then choose the replacement colour in the pop-up. Click OK when you are finished.
