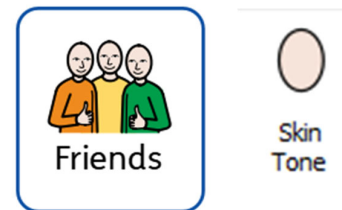


## Shuffled Skin Tones

Sometimes you will want a symbol depicting different people to use different skin tones. InPrint 4 has a feature that allows you to easily change skin tones randomly for **Widgit Symbols**.

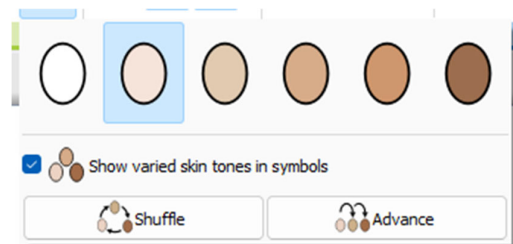
### Changing the Skin Tone of symbols

1. When you have written or placed a symbol in a document select **Skin Tone** from the **Formatting** tab.

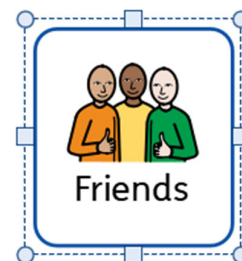


2. The **Skin Tone** menu will open. Tick the **Show varied skin tones in symbols** box and then select **Shuffle** to randomise the Skin Tones of the users in the symbol. Click **OK** when you are finished.

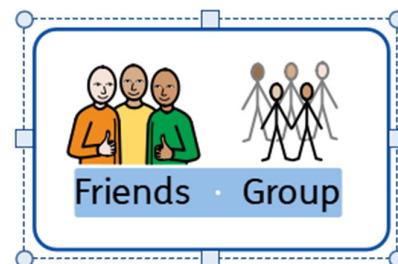
The **Advance** button will change the symbol's skin tone to the next skin tone in the list.



3. The symbol will now display a random variation of skin tone, you can shuffle again to change the skin tones again.



4. You can shuffle the skin tone of multiple symbols at once by highlighting all the words ahead of using the Shuffle Skin Tone button



## Some symbols can't be changed

1. Some individuals and groups cannot have their skin tones changed, either individually or shuffled.
